The following individuals shall be eligible for awards:

- a. Dependent children of eligible members.
- b. Dependent children of deceased members provided, that the member was in continuous good standing, for twelve (12) consecutive months prior to and including the month of his/her death during the scholastic year the award is given.
- 1. "Children" shall include stepchildren and Jegally adopted children.
- 2. "Eligible Members" shall be define as those members of the Local Union that have been in continuous good standing for at least twelve (12) consecutive months prior to and including the month of application.
- 3. "Good standing" is defined as a member having his initiation fee, monthly dues, assessments and/or fines paid in full.
- 4. Children of Officers, Business Agents, Organizers and Employees of the Local Union are not eligible to participate.
- 5. Awards will be issued for students accepted and entering accredited Universities, Colleges, Junior Colleges and Technical Institutes.
- 6. Only those students graduating from high school in the year the award is given are eligible for the award.
- 7. All awards will be paid directly to the school in which the student is enrolled. Any unused monies from the award shall be returned to Teamsters Local Union 633 if for any reason the student withdraws from school during the year for which the award was made.
- 8. Scholarships may be applied only towards legitimate school expenses such as tuition, room, board, books and miscellaneous expenses.
- 9. Applications must be submitted on forms furnished by the Local Union and must be returned by July 15th of the current year along with a letter of acceptance from a college and the full four (4) year high school transcript.
- 10. All amendments to these rules shall be effective upon approval of the Local Union Executive Board.
